These charts show body measurements. Be sure to measure yourself to find the accurate size.

HOW TO MEASURE

For best results, have someone else take measurements. Measure body in underwear. Tape must be snug but not tight. If measurements fall between two sizes, order the larger size.

CHEST/BUST:

Measure under your arms, around the fullest part of your chest.

WAIST:

Measure around your natural waistline, keeping one finger between the tape and body.

GLOVES:

Measure palm width.



TECHNICAL TERMINOLOGY

BRP FABRICS

BRP-standard fabrics whose outermost layers are DWR treated with Teflon (dark colors) or Teflon HT (light colors). All BRP fabrics are rigorously tested for abrasion resistance.

TEFLON

Teflon provides an invisible barrier around the fabric's fibers to repel water and stains. As for Teflon HT, in addition to retaining its water shedding properties longer than standard Teflon, Teflon HT is also even more resistant to soiling and staining without altering the fabric's color, appearance, structure, texture and breathability.

RPM

Respiractive Performance Matrix or RPM coating is a proprietary treatment developed specifically by BRP. It is applied to the outer fabric surface to deliver the perfect balance of waterproofness and breathability like no other product on the market.
